



B2B Toolkit for WooCommerce User Guide

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Version 1.0

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1. Introduction

The **TW WooCommerce B2B Toolkit** helps store owners control product visibility, pricing access, Add to Cart functionality, quote requests, and bulk product pricing in WooCommerce stores.

The plugin is designed for:

- B2B WooCommerce stores
- Wholesale-style stores
- Catalog-mode websites
- Restricted-price stores
- Role-based WooCommerce setups

Using this plugin, store owners can:

- Hide prices for guest users
- Disable Add to Cart functionality
- Hide prices for out-of-stock products
- Create category, product, tag, and brand-based visibility rules
- Schedule visibility rules using date and time controls
- Display custom guest-facing messages
- Apply catalog-style behavior to WooCommerce stores
- Update product prices in bulk or for selected products
- Increase or decrease prices using percentage or fixed pricing rules
- Apply pricing updates by category or selected products
- Enable Request a Quote on single product pages
- Replace or display the Request a Quote button alongside Add to Cart
- Collect customer quote requests with an optional message field
- Receive quote requests directly through email

The Bulk Price Manager allows store owners to update WooCommerce product pricing using flexible bulk pricing rules quickly.

This feature is useful for:

- Bulk price updates
- Seasonal pricing adjustments
- Wholesale-style pricing management
- Category-based price updates
- Fast product pricing changes

Visibility behavior can be customized for guests and specific WooCommerce user roles.

2. Features

1. **User Role Restrictions:** Apply hide price rules to selected logged-in user roles. When enabled, all restriction features will apply to the selected user roles as well as guest users. This includes

Global Add to Cart Disable, Out of Stock Visibility Control, Scheduled Visibility, and Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart by Category, Product, Tag, or Brand.

2. **Request a Quote:** Display a Request a Quote button alongside the Add to Cart button on single product pages or replace Add to Cart buttons throughout the WooCommerce store. Available for guest users and selected restricted user roles.
3. **Quote Message Field:** Optionally allow customers to include additional information when submitting a quote request.
4. **Global Add to Cart Disable:** Disable the Add to Cart functionality for all products. This applies to guest users and restricted user roles when enabled.
5. **Out-of-Stock Visibility Control:** Automatically hide prices and disable Add to Cart buttons for all out-of-stock products. This works for guest users and restricted user roles when enabled.
6. **Scheduled Visibility:** Schedule price hiding and Add to Cart restrictions for specific dates and times. These scheduled rules apply to guest users and restricted user roles. During the scheduled period, the Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart feature, including its Category, Product, Tag, and Brand-based restrictions, follows the configured schedule.
7. **Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart:** Hide product prices and disable Add to Cart buttons for all WooCommerce products. Optionally limit the restrictions to selected categories, products, tags, or brands.
8. **Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart by Category:** Hide prices and disable Add to Cart buttons for products in selected categories.
9. **Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart by Product:** Hide prices and disable Add to Cart buttons for selected products.
10. **Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart by Tag:** Hide prices and disable Add to Cart buttons for products with selected tags.
11. **Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart by Brand:** Hide prices and disable Add to Cart buttons for products from selected brands.
12. **Global Add to Cart Message:** Display a custom tooltip message when hovering over the Add to Cart button when Global Add to Cart Disable is enabled.
13. **Add to Cart Message:** Display a custom tooltip message when hovering over disabled Add to Cart buttons. This message appears when restrictions are applied through category, product, Tag, or brand-based rules.
14. **Price Message:** Display a custom tooltip message when hovering over hidden prices. This message appears when restrictions are applied through category, product, Tag, or brand-based rules.
15. **Out of Stock Price Message:** Display a custom tooltip message on both the hidden price and disabled Add to Cart button when Out of Stock Visibility Control is enabled.
16. **Schedule Active Message:** Display a custom tooltip message on both the hidden price and disabled Add to Cart button while scheduled visibility is active.
17. **Role Restricted Message:** Display a custom tooltip message on both prices and Add to Cart buttons for restricted user roles when user role restrictions are enabled.
18. **Quote Success Message:** Display a custom confirmation message after a customer successfully submits a quote request.
19. **Bulk Price Manager:** Update product prices individually or in bulk.
20. **Percentage Price Rules:** Increase or decrease prices using percentage values.
21. **Flat Price Rules:** Apply fixed-amount price adjustments.
22. **Bulk Operations:** Quickly increase or decrease prices across products.
23. **Category-Based Bulk Pricing:** Update prices for selected categories.
24. **Flexible Pricing Values:** Supports custom numeric values, including decimals

- 25. Product Selection Table:** Select multiple or individual products for price updates.
- 26. Recent Bulk Changes Table:** View a log of recent bulk updates, including the last updated date and time, bulk update type, category, assigned value, and the total number of products affected.

3. Installation Guide

3.1. Method 1 — Upload Plugin ZIP

1. Log in to your WordPress admin dashboard.
2. Go to Plugins > Add New.
3. Click Upload Plugin.
4. Select the B2B Toolkit plugin ZIP file.
5. Click Install Now.
6. After installation, verify your plugin license and click the Activate Plugin button to complete the activation process.

Quick Tip: You can download your plugin ZIP file at any time via the following:

- The **purchase confirmation email** has been sent to your inbox.
- Your personal **Freemius account** dashboard.

3.2. Method 2 — Manual Installation

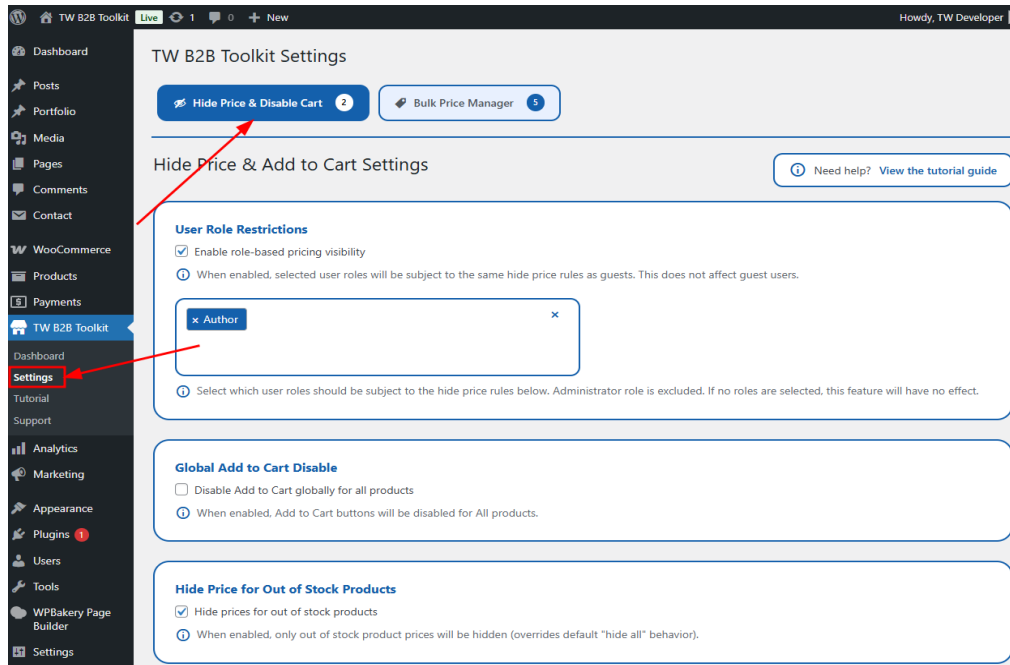
1. Place the plugin Zip file in: /wp-content/plugins/
2. Extract the plugin ZIP file.
3. Log in to WordPress Admin.
4. Go to Plugins.
5. After file upload, verify your plugin license and click the Activate Plugin button to complete the activation process.

4. Setup Guide

4.1. Hide Price & Add to Cart Settings

Access Plugin Settings:

- Log in to WordPress Admin.
- Navigate to: TW B2B Toolkit > Settings
- Open the **Hide Price & Disable Cart** section.



Default Behavior:

By default:

- Product prices and Add to Cart buttons remain visible for all users.
- No visibility or purchasing restrictions are applied until one or more restriction settings are configured and saved.
- Once enabled, the configured restrictions apply to guest users by default. If **User Role Restrictions** are enabled, the same restrictions also apply to the selected logged-in user roles.

4.1.1. User Role Restrictions

The User Role Restrictions feature allows store owners to apply hidden prices and purchasing restrictions to selected logged-in WooCommerce user roles in addition to guest users.

This helps create controlled B2B, wholesale-style, catalog-mode, or restricted-access WooCommerce stores where only approved users can view pricing or purchase products.

Features Affected by User Role Restrictions:

- Request a Quote
- Global Add to Cart Disable
- Out-of-Stock Visibility Control
- Scheduled Visibility Rules
- Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart Button

How It Works

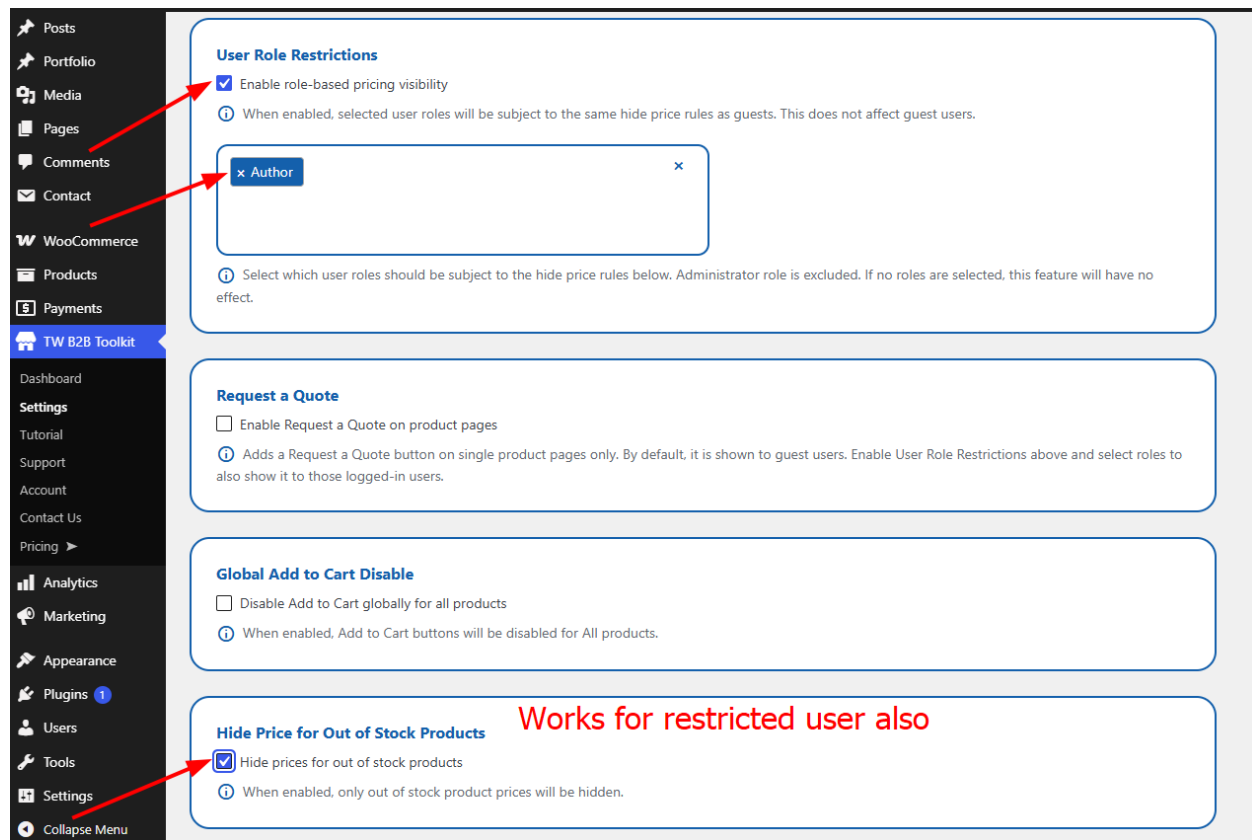
When enabled:

- Guest users will continue following all configured restrictions.
- Selected logged-in user roles will also follow the same restrictions.
- Administrator users are automatically excluded to prevent accidental store access issues.

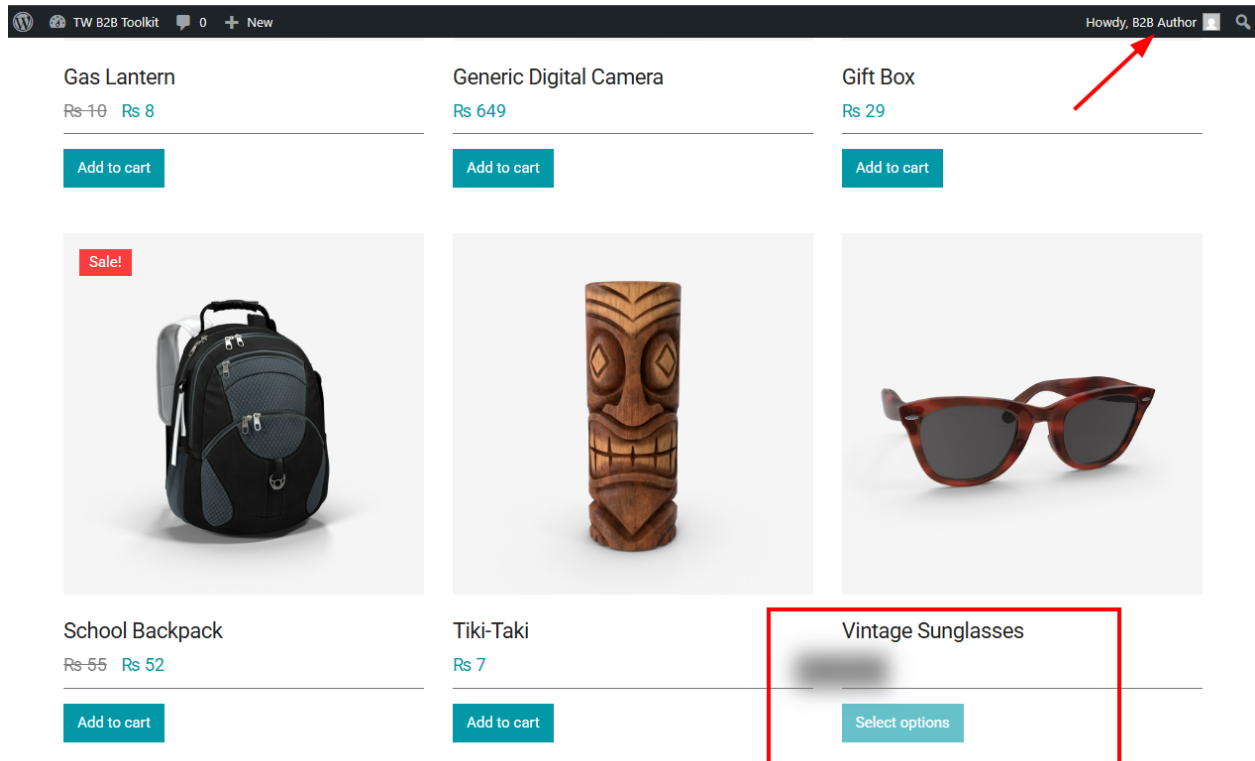
Steps to Enable:

1. Open plugin settings.
2. Enable the **User Role Restrictions**.
3. Select the user roles to restrict.
4. Save settings.

4.1.2. Request a Quote

The Request a Quote feature allows store owners to replace or supplement WooCommerce purchasing with a quote request option..

This feature is ideal for B2B stores, wholesale businesses, custom-priced products, and products that require customer quotations before purchase.

By default, the Request a Quote button is displayed for guest users. If User Role Restrictions are enabled, the button can also be shown to selected logged-in user roles.

How It Works

When enabled:

- Guest users can submit quote requests by default.
- If **User Role Restrictions** are enabled, selected logged-in user roles can also access the Request a Quote feature.
- Administrator users are automatically excluded from these restrictions.
- Customers can submit a quote request by providing their Company Name, Company Email, Quantity, Target Price, and an optional message.
- Quote requests are sent directly to the configured store email address.

Button Display Mode

Choose how the Request a Quote button is displayed:

Show Add to Cart Button Alongside Quote:

- Displays both the Add to Cart button and the Request a Quote button on single product pages only.
- Shop, category, tag, and other product archive pages continue to display the standard Add to Cart button.

Replace Add to Cart with Request a Quote:

- Replaces the Add to Cart button with the Request a Quote button throughout the WooCommerce store.
- The Request a Quote button is displayed on single product pages, shop pages, category pages, tag pages, and other product archive pages wherever the Add to Cart button normally appears.
- Customers can submit a quote request instead of purchasing products directly.

Quote Message Field

The quote form includes an optional **Message** field that can be enabled or disabled.

- When enabled, customers can provide additional requirements, product specifications, or purchasing information.
- When disabled, the quote form displays only the default fields.

Quote Success Message

After a quote request is submitted successfully:

- Customers will see the configured success message.
- If no custom message is provided, the default message is displayed: ***Thank you! Your quote request has been submitted successfully. We'll get back to you shortly.***

Steps to Enable

1. Open the plugin settings.
2. Enable **Request a Quote**.
3. Select the preferred **Button Display Mode**.
4. Optionally enable the **Message** field.
5. Optionally customize the **Quote Success Message**.
6. Save the plugin settings.

Adds a Request a Quote button on single product pages only. By default, it is shown to guest users. Enable User Role Restrictions above and select roles to also show it to those logged-in users.

Button display mode

The quote button appears only on the product detail page, not on shop or category listings. Visible to guest users and any user roles selected in User Role Restrictions.

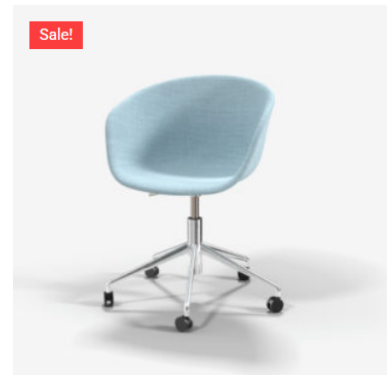

4.1.3. Global Add to Cart Disable

The Global Add to Cart Disable feature allows store owners to disable the Add to Cart functionality across the entire WooCommerce store.

When enabled, customers affected by the restriction will no longer be able to add products to the cart from shop pages, product pages, or other WooCommerce product listings.

How It Works

When enabled:

- All Add to Cart buttons are disabled store-wide.
- Product prices remain visible
- The restriction applies to guest users by default.
- If **User Role Restrictions** is enabled, the restriction will also apply to the selected logged-in user roles.
- Administrator users are automatically excluded from restrictions.

Rule Priority:

When enabled, this feature overrides and disables the following restriction features:

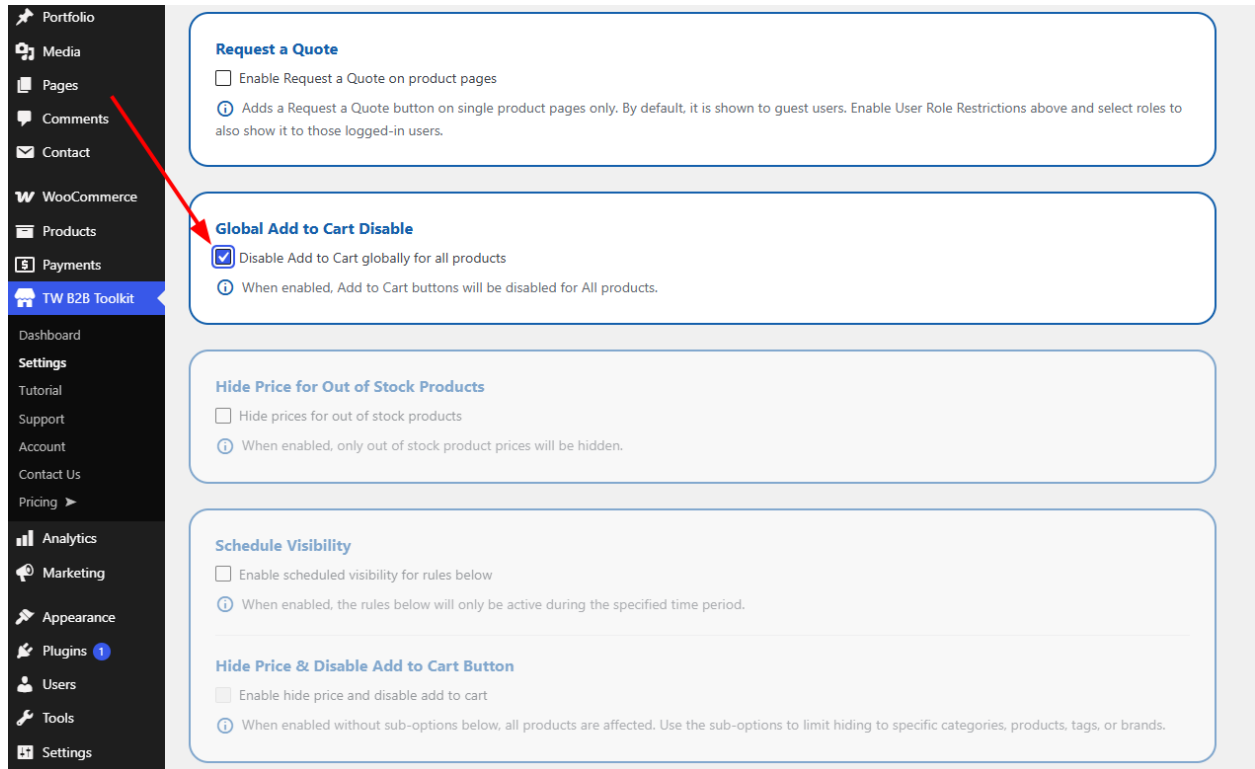
- Out-of-Stock Visibility Control
- Scheduled Visibility
- Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart Button

This ensures that the selected priority rule takes precedence over all other visibility and purchasing restrictions.

Steps to Enable:

1. Open plugin settings.
2. Enable the **Global Add to Cart Disable**.
3. Save settings.

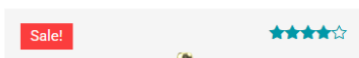

4.1.4. Hide Price for Out-of-Stock Products

The Out of Stock Visibility Control feature allows store owners to automatically hide product prices and disable Add to Cart functionality for out-of-stock WooCommerce products.

How It Works

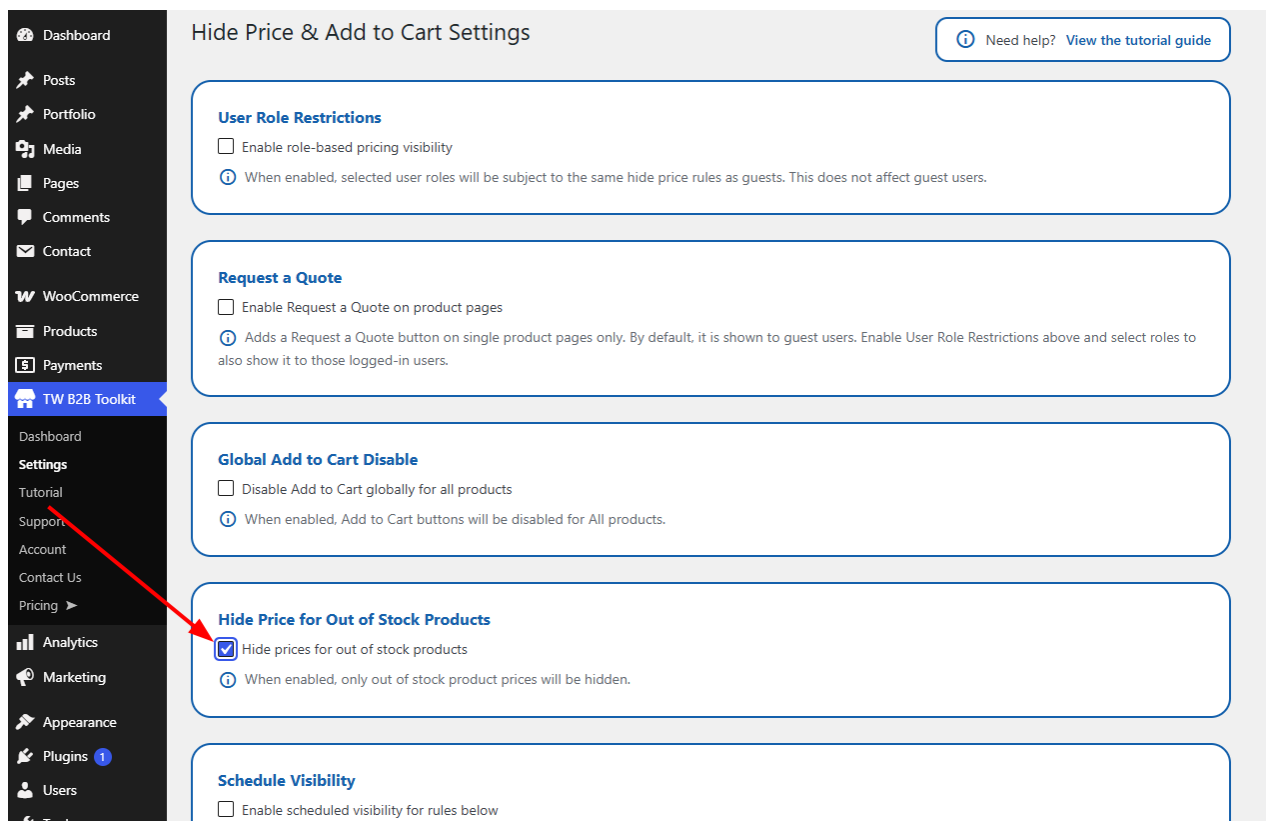
When enabled:

- Prices are automatically hidden for all out-of-stock products.
- Add to Cart buttons are disabled for out-of-stock products.
- In-stock products continue to display normally unless affected by other configured visibility restrictions.
- The restriction applies to guest users by default.
- If **User Role Restrictions** is enabled, the same restrictions will also apply to selected logged-in user roles.
- Administrator users are automatically excluded from restrictions.

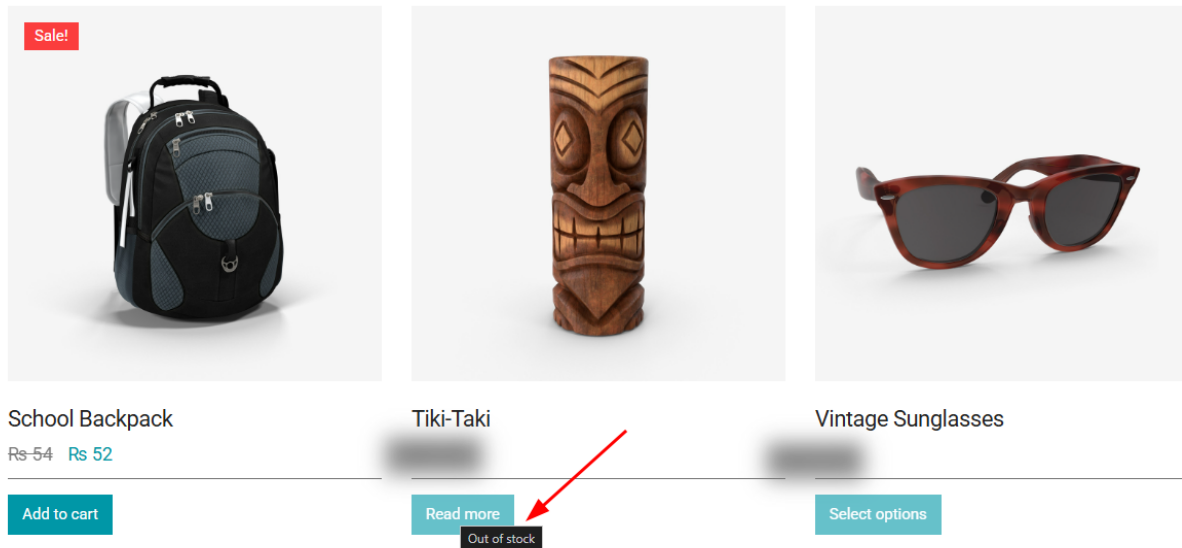
Steps to Enable:

1. Open plugin settings.
2. Enable the **Hide Price for Out-of-Stock Products**.
3. Save settings.

4.1.5. Schedule Visibility:

The **Scheduled Visibility** feature allows store owners to automatically control when **Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart** restrictions become active using date and time scheduling.

This feature helps automate temporary catalog restrictions, limited access periods, pre-launch product visibility, and time-based purchasing control without requiring manual changes.

How It Works

When enabled:

- **Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart** restrictions become active only during the configured schedule period.
- Outside the scheduled period, all scheduled visibility restrictions are automatically disabled.
- The restrictions apply to guest users by default.
- If **User Role Restrictions** are enabled, the same scheduled restrictions also apply to the selected logged-in user roles.
- Administrator users are automatically excluded from restrictions.

Supported Scheduled Restrictions:

When **Scheduled Visibility** is enabled, it controls the **Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart** feature, including the following optional sub-options:

- Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart by Category
- Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart by Product
- Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart by Tag
- Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart by Brand

Restrictions Not Affected by Scheduling:

The following features work independently and are not controlled by Scheduled Visibility:

- Request a Quote
- Global Add to Cart Disable
- Out-of-Stock Visibility Control

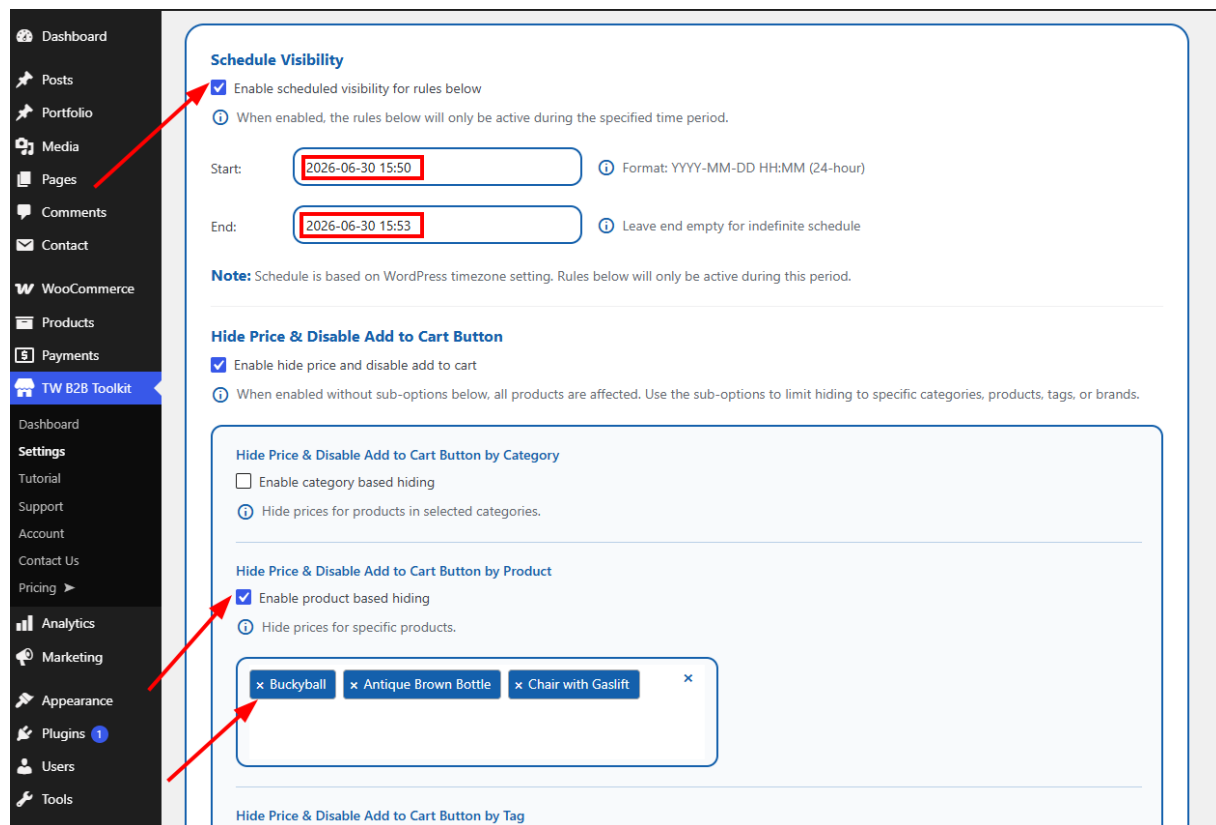
How to Configure Schedule:

1. Enable **Scheduled Visibility**.
2. Select the **Start Date** and **Start Time**.
3. Optionally select the **End Date** and **End Time**.
4. Save the plugin settings.

Schedule Behavior:

- If no end date is configured, the restrictions remain active indefinitely after the start date.
- The schedule uses the timezone configured in WordPress settings.
- Restrictions activate and deactivate automatically based on the configured date and time.

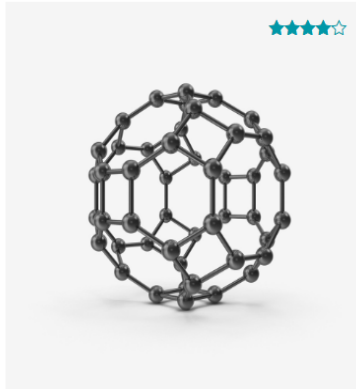

4.1.6. Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart

The **Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart** feature allows store owners to hide product prices and disable Add to Cart functionality for guest users and selected restricted user roles.

By default, enabling this feature without configuring any of the sub-options applies the restrictions to **all WooCommerce products**. To limit the restrictions to specific products, enable one or more of the available sub-options for Categories, Products, Tags, or Brands.

How It Works

When enabled:

- Product prices are hidden and Add to Cart buttons are disabled.
- If no sub-options are enabled, the restrictions apply to all WooCommerce products.
- Enable one or more sub-options to limit the restrictions to selected categories, products, tags, or brands.
- The restrictions apply to guest users by default.
- If **User Role Restrictions** are enabled, the same restrictions also apply to the selected logged-in user roles.
- Administrator users are automatically excluded from restrictions.

Schedule Compatibility

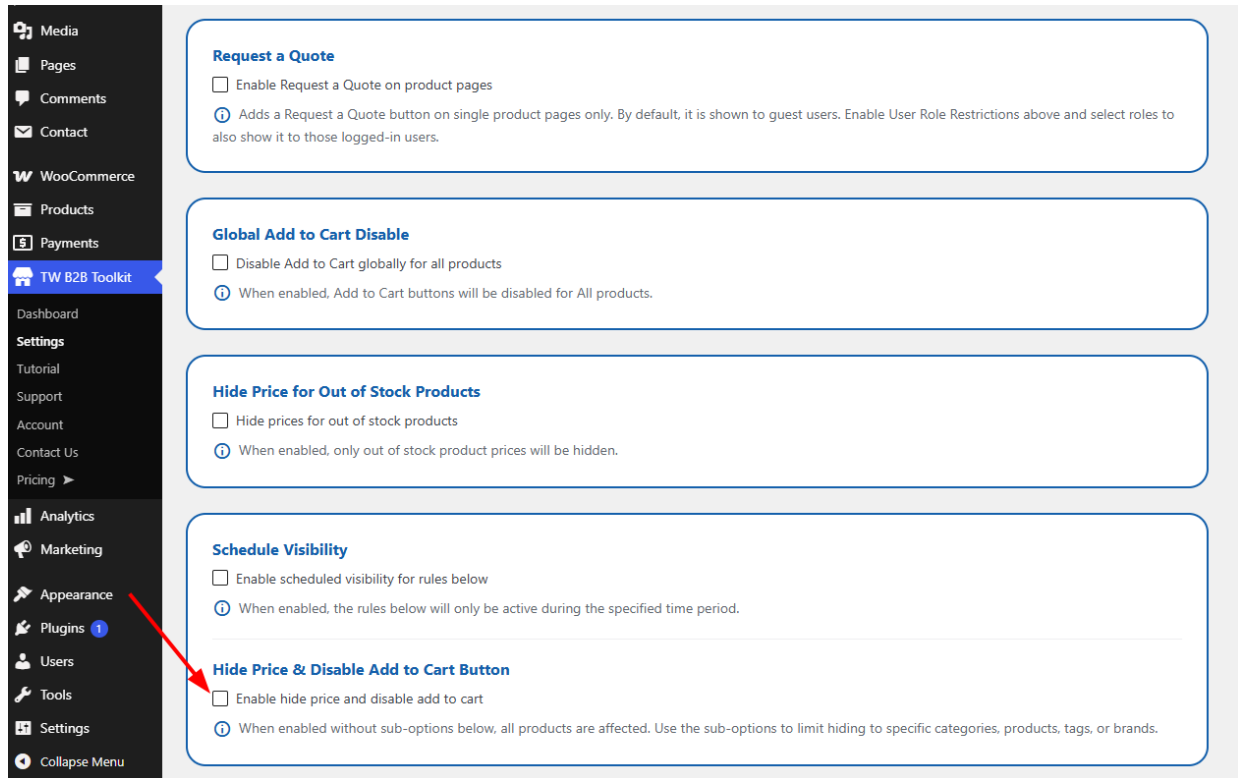
If **Scheduled Visibility** is enabled:

- All configured Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart rules become active only during the configured schedule period.
- Outside the scheduled period, the configured restrictions are automatically disabled.

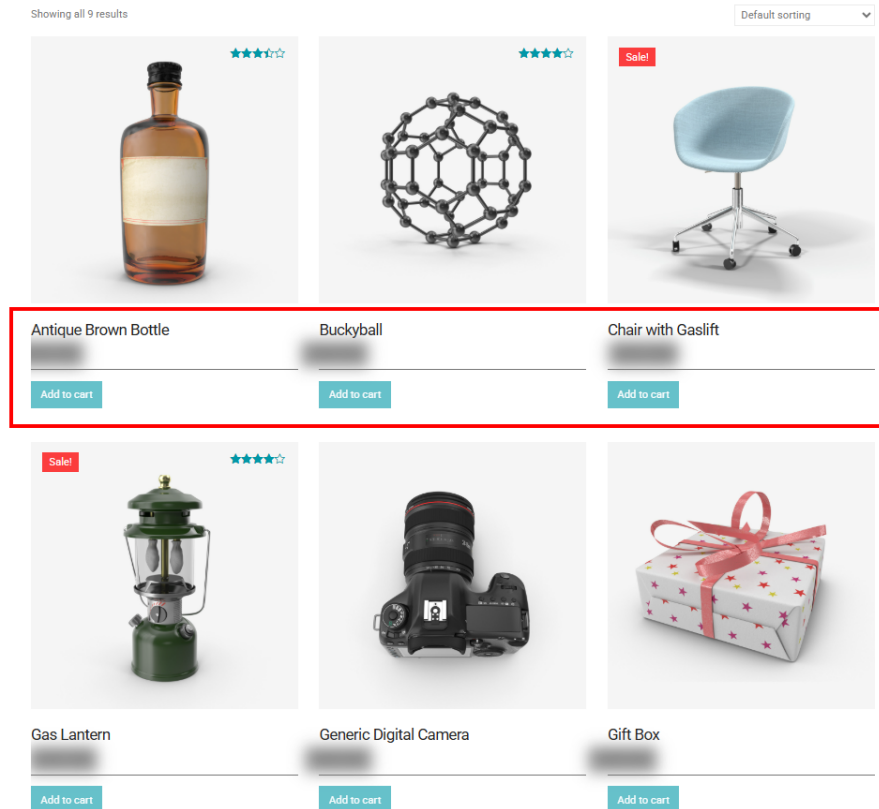

4.1.6.1. Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart by Category

The **Category-Based Rules** feature allows store owners to limit visibility restrictions to products within selected WooCommerce product categories.

How It Works

When enabled:

- Only products within the selected categories will have prices hidden and Add to Cart buttons disabled.
- Category restrictions are applied only when the parent Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart feature is enabled.
- The restrictions apply to guest users by default.
- If **User Role Restrictions** are enabled, the same restrictions also apply to the selected logged-in user roles.

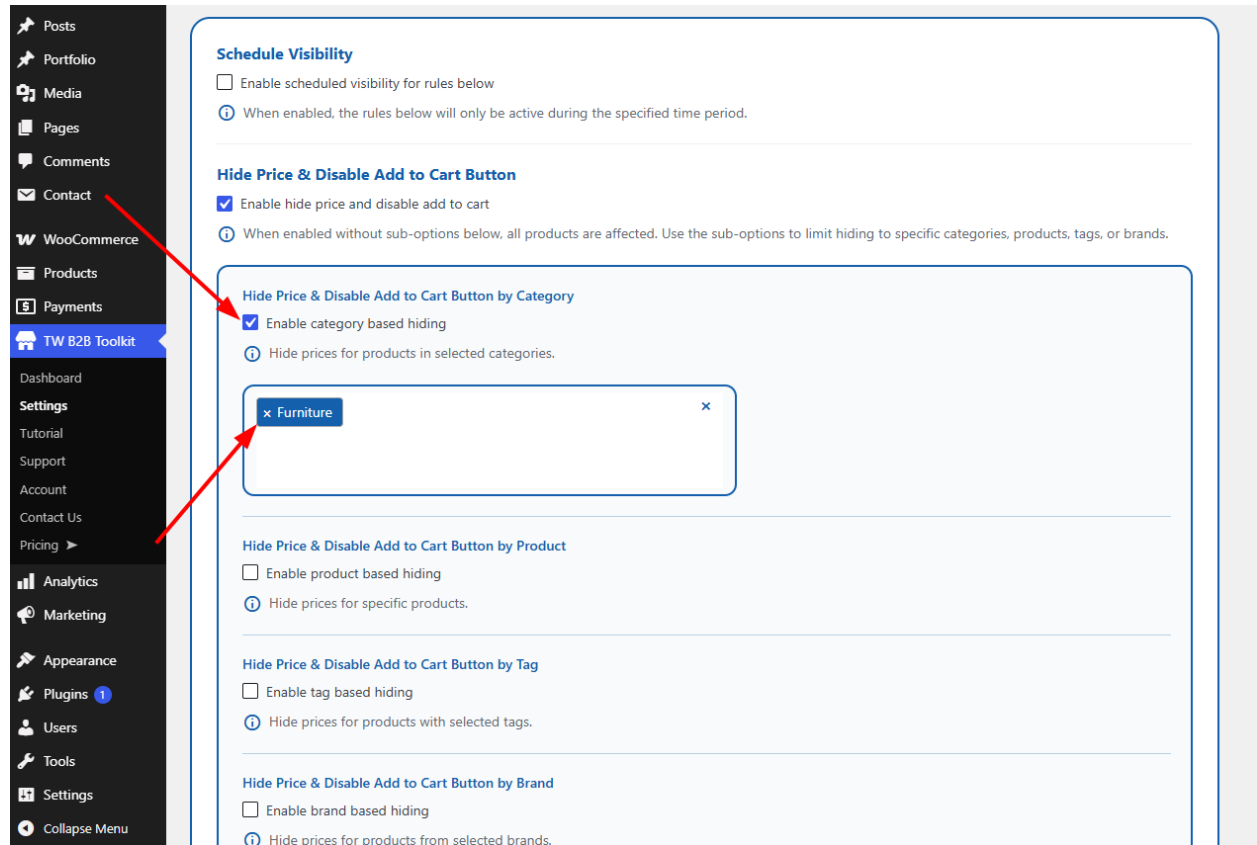

4.1.6.2. Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart by Product

The **Product-Based Rules** feature allows store owners to apply visibility restrictions to specific WooCommerce products.

How It Works

When enabled:

- Only the selected products will have prices hidden and Add to Cart buttons disabled.
- Product restrictions are applied only when the parent **Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart** feature is enabled.
- The restrictions apply to guest users by default.
- If **User Role Restrictions** are enabled, the same restrictions also apply to the selected logged-in user roles.

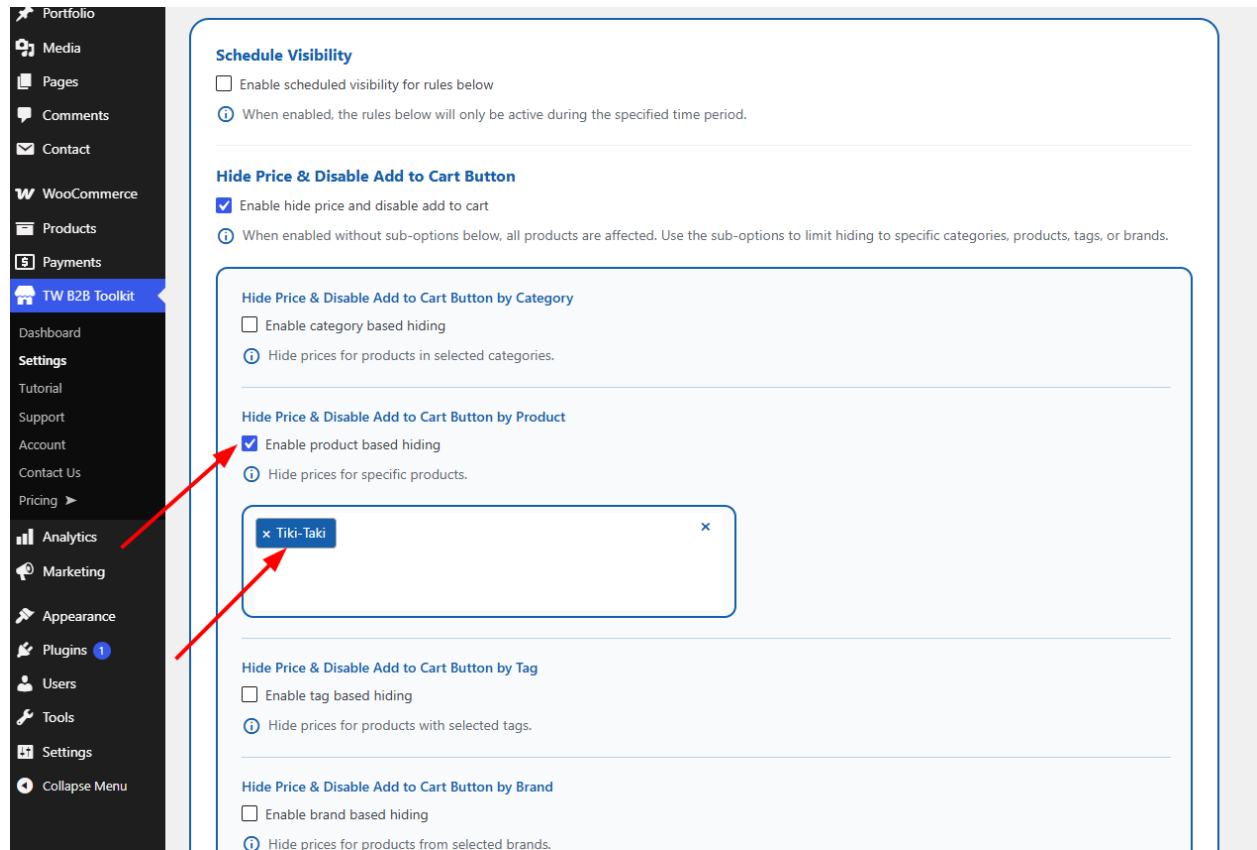

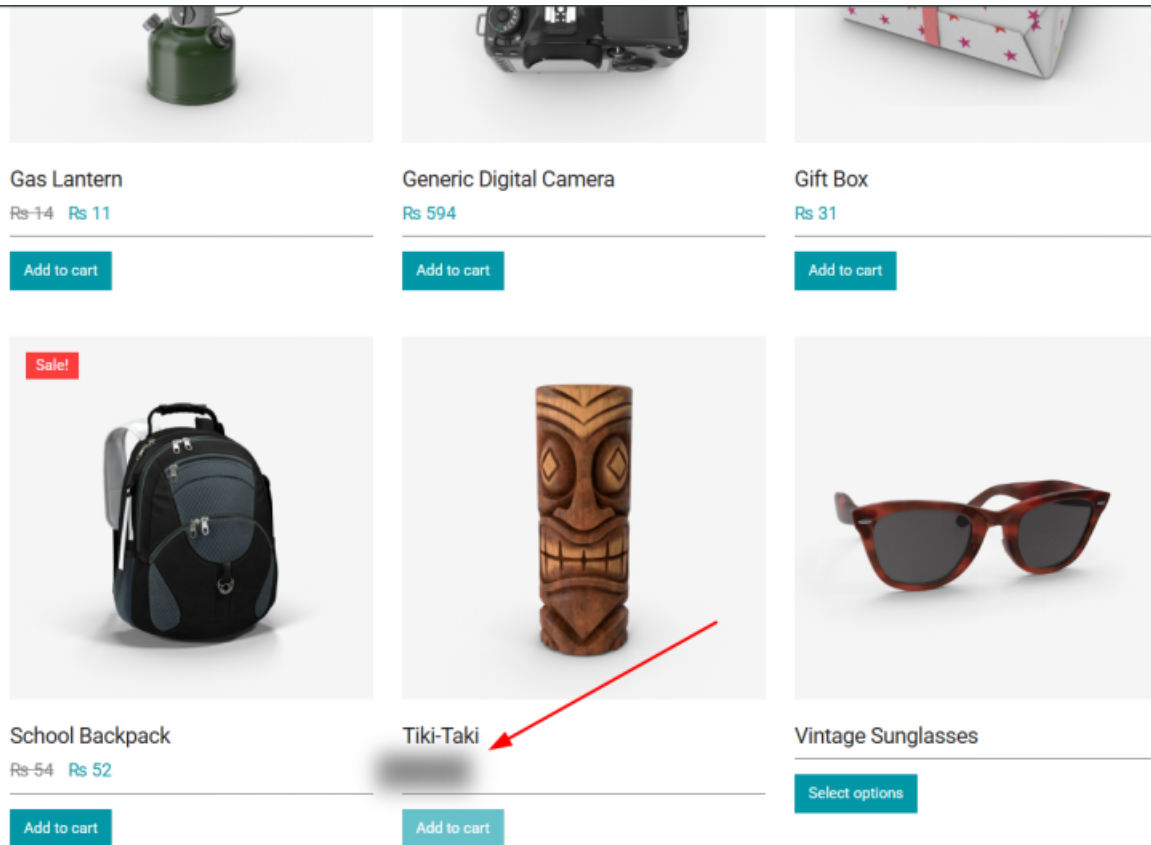

4.1.6.3. Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart by Tag

The **Tag-Based Rules** feature allows store owners to limit visibility restrictions to products assigned to selected WooCommerce product tags.

How It Works

When enabled:

- Only products with the selected tags will have prices hidden and Add to Cart buttons disabled.
- Tag restrictions are applied only when the parent **Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart** feature is enabled.
- The restrictions apply to guest users by default.
- If **User Role Restrictions** are enabled, the same restrictions also apply to the selected logged-in user roles.

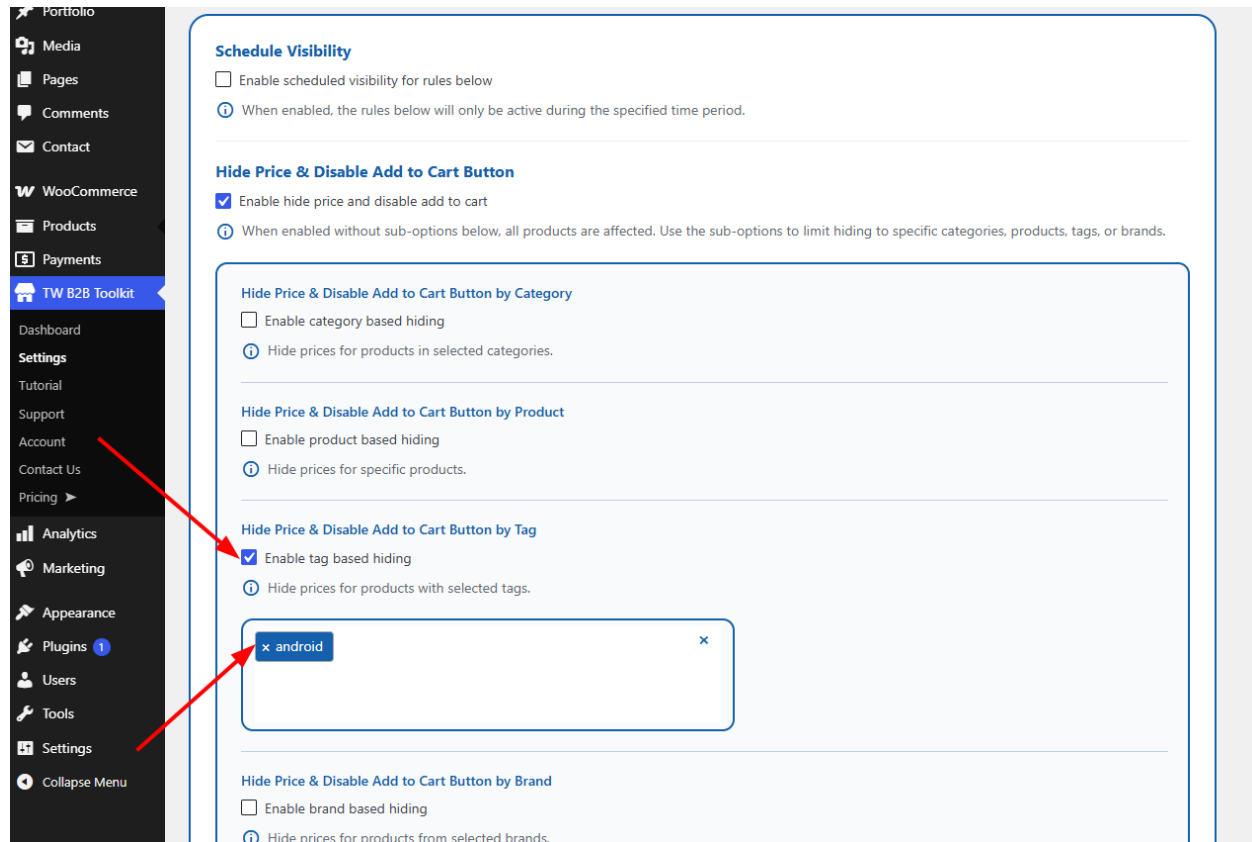
Steps to Configure:

1. Open the plugin settings page.
2. Enable **Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart**.
3. Enable **Tag Based Hiding**.
4. Select the WooCommerce product tags.

4.1.6.4. Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart by Brand

The **Brand-Based Rules** feature allows store owners to limit visibility restrictions to products assigned to selected product brands.

How It Works

When enabled:

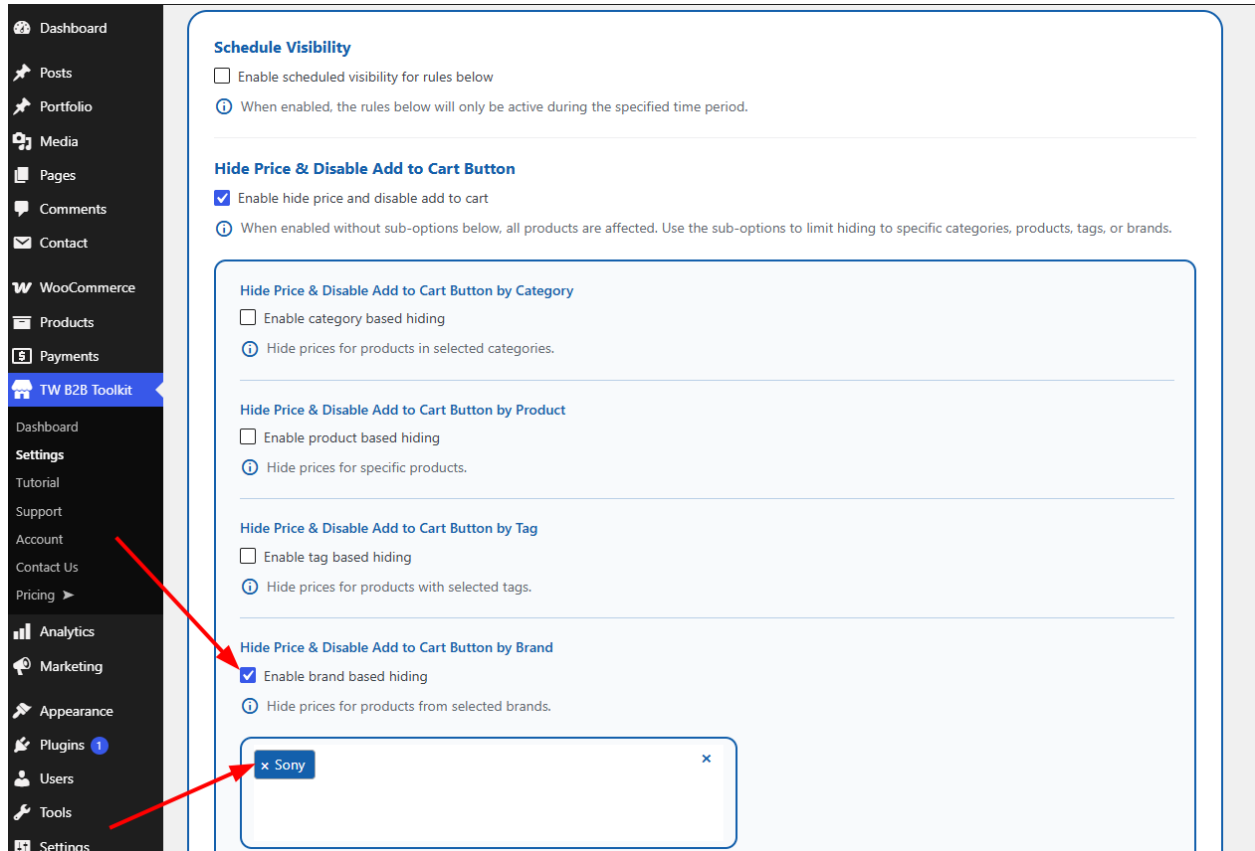
- Only products assigned to the selected brands will have prices hidden and Add to Cart buttons disabled.
- Brand restrictions are applied only when the parent **Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart** feature is enabled.
- The restrictions apply to guest users by default.
- If **User Role Restrictions** are enabled, the same restrictions also apply to the selected logged-in user roles.

Steps to Configure:

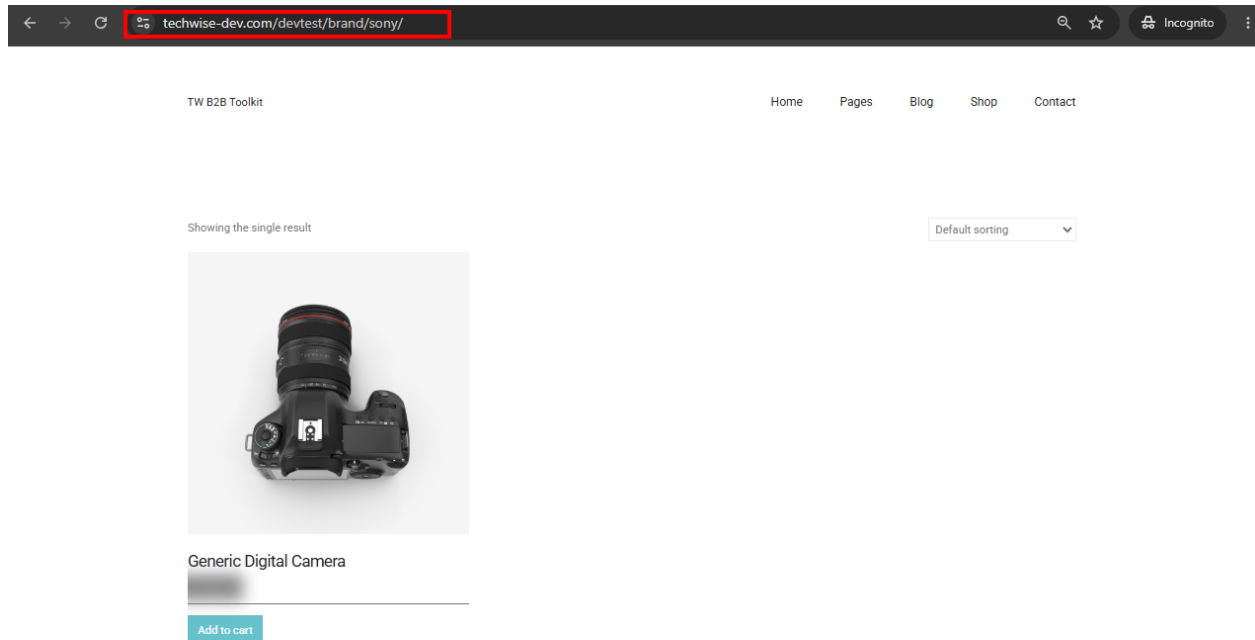
1. Open the plugin settings page.
2. Enable **Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart**.
3. Enable **Brand Based Hiding**.

4. Select the product brands.
5. Save the plugin settings.

Multiple Rules

When multiple rules are enabled:

- Products matching ANY enabled rule are affected
- The plugin uses OR logic

Example: Category A OR Product B OR Tag C

4.1.7. Custom Messages

The Custom Messages feature allows store owners to display custom text messages on hover instead of WooCommerce product prices or Add to Cart buttons when visibility restrictions are active.

4.1.7.1. Global Add to Cart Message

The Global Add to Cart Message feature allows store owners to display a custom tooltip message on disabled Add to Cart buttons when the Global Add to Cart Disable feature is active.

This helps customers understand why purchasing is unavailable instead of seeing inactive buttons without explanation.

How It Works

When the **Global Add to Cart Disable** feature is enabled:

- The tooltip message feature is automatically activated.
- By default, the plugin displays the message "Add to cart is currently disabled."
- A custom tooltip message appears when users hover over disabled Add to Cart buttons.

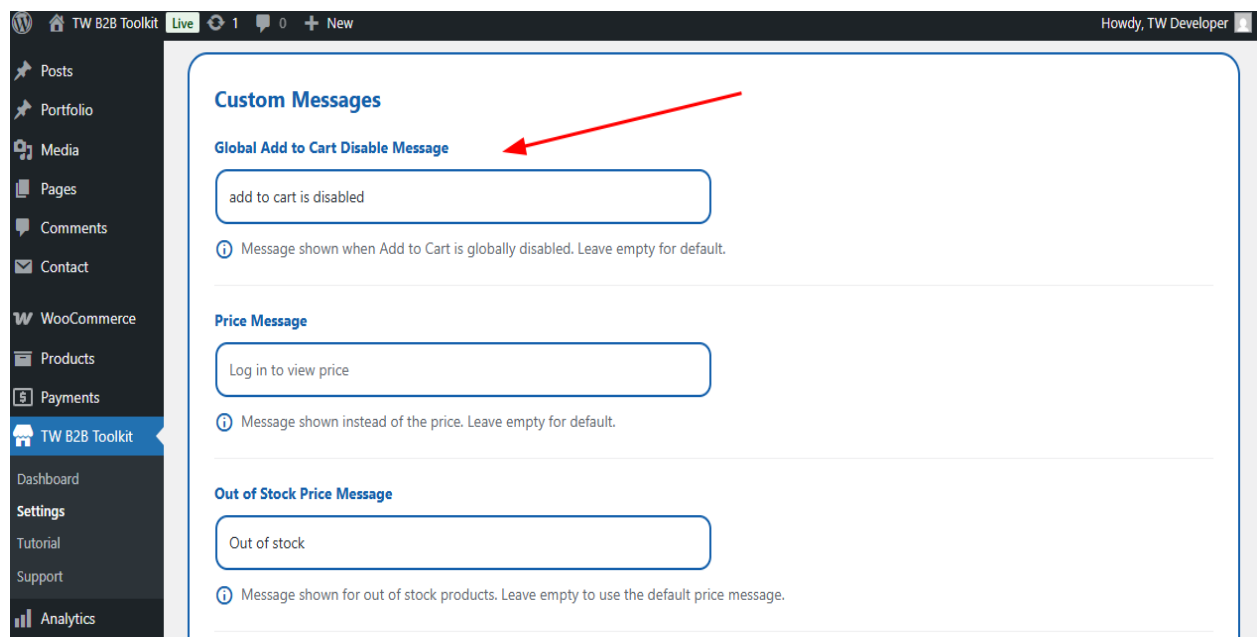
- The message is displayed only when Global Add to Cart Disable is active.

Steps to Configure:

1. Open the plugin settings page.
2. Enable **Global Add to Cart Disable**.
3. Enter a custom tooltip message.
4. Save the plugin settings.

Once enabled, customers will see the configured tooltip message when hovering over disabled Add to Cart buttons.

4.1.7.2. Add to Cart Message

The Add to Cart Message feature allows store owners to display a custom tooltip message when users hover over disabled Add to Cart buttons affected by visibility restriction rules.

This improves customer communication by explaining why purchasing is restricted.

How It Works

When the **Hide Price and Disable Add to Cart by Category, Product, Tag, and Brand** feature is enabled:

- The tooltip message feature is automatically activated.
- By default, the plugin displays the message "Login to add to cart."
- A custom tooltip message appears when users hover over disabled Add to Cart buttons.
- The tooltip is displayed when restrictions are **applied through**:
 - Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart by Category
 - Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart by Product
 - Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart by Tag
 - Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart by Brand

Schedule Compatibility:

If **Scheduled Visibility** is enabled:

- The Add to Cart tooltip message will only appear during the active schedule period.

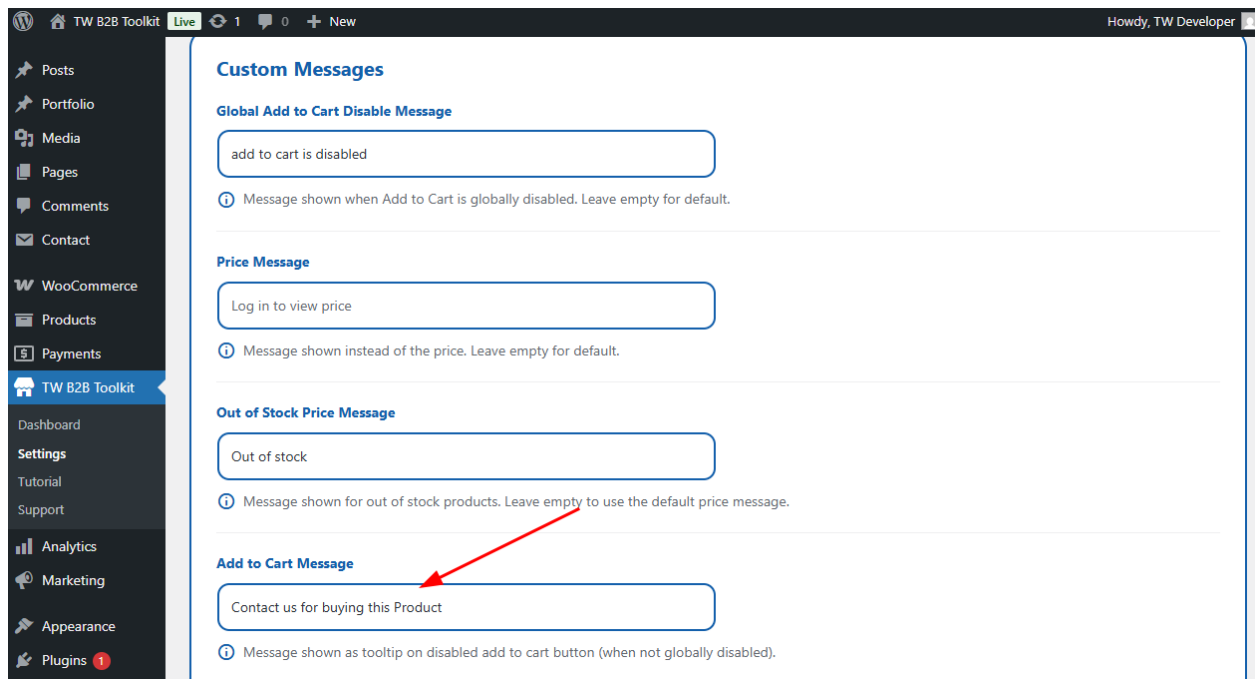
- During the scheduled restriction period, the configured **Schedule Active Message** will override the default Add to Cart tooltip message.

Steps to Configure:

1. Open the plugin settings page.
2. Configure your visibility restriction rules.
3. Enter a custom Add to Cart tooltip message.
4. Save the plugin settings.

Once enabled, customers will see the configured tooltip message when hovering over restricted Add to Cart buttons.

4.1.7.3. Price Message

The Price Message feature allows store owners to display a custom tooltip message when users hover over hidden product prices.

This helps explain pricing restrictions instead of leaving empty or hidden price areas without context.

How It Works

When the **Hide Price and Disable Add to Cart by Category, Product, Tag, and Brand** feature is enabled:

- The tooltip message feature is automatically activated.
- By default, the plugin displays the message "Login to view price."
- A custom tooltip message appears when users hover over hidden prices.
- The tooltip is displayed when restrictions are applied through:
 - Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart by Category
 - Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart by Product
 - Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart by Tag
 - Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart by Brand

Schedule Compatibility:

If **Scheduled Visibility** is enabled:

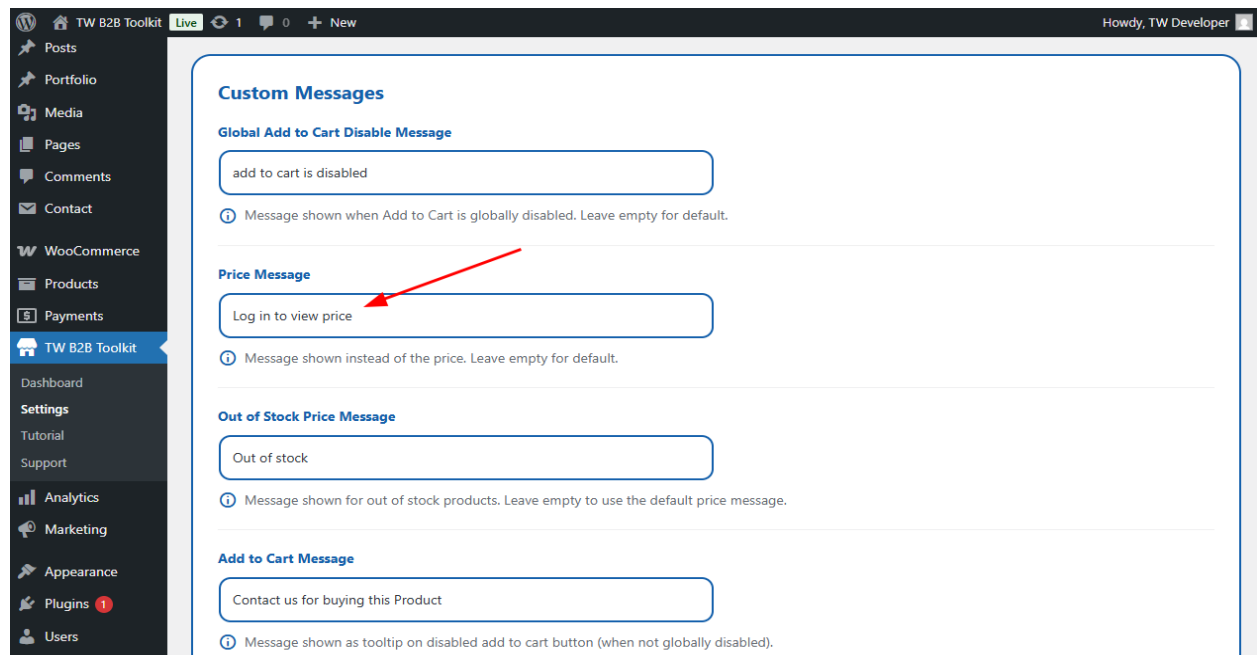
- The price tooltip message will only appear during the active schedule period.
- During the scheduled restriction period, the configured **Schedule Active Message** will override the default Price tooltip message.

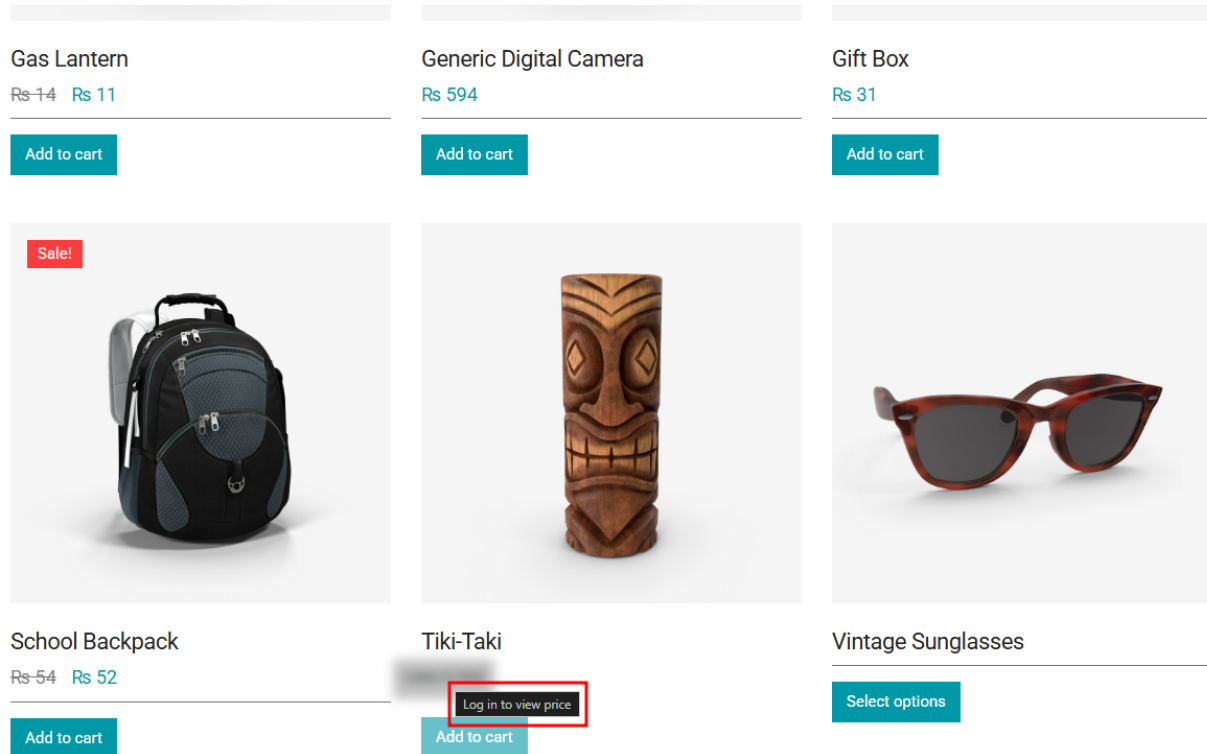

4.1.7.4. Out of Stock Price Message

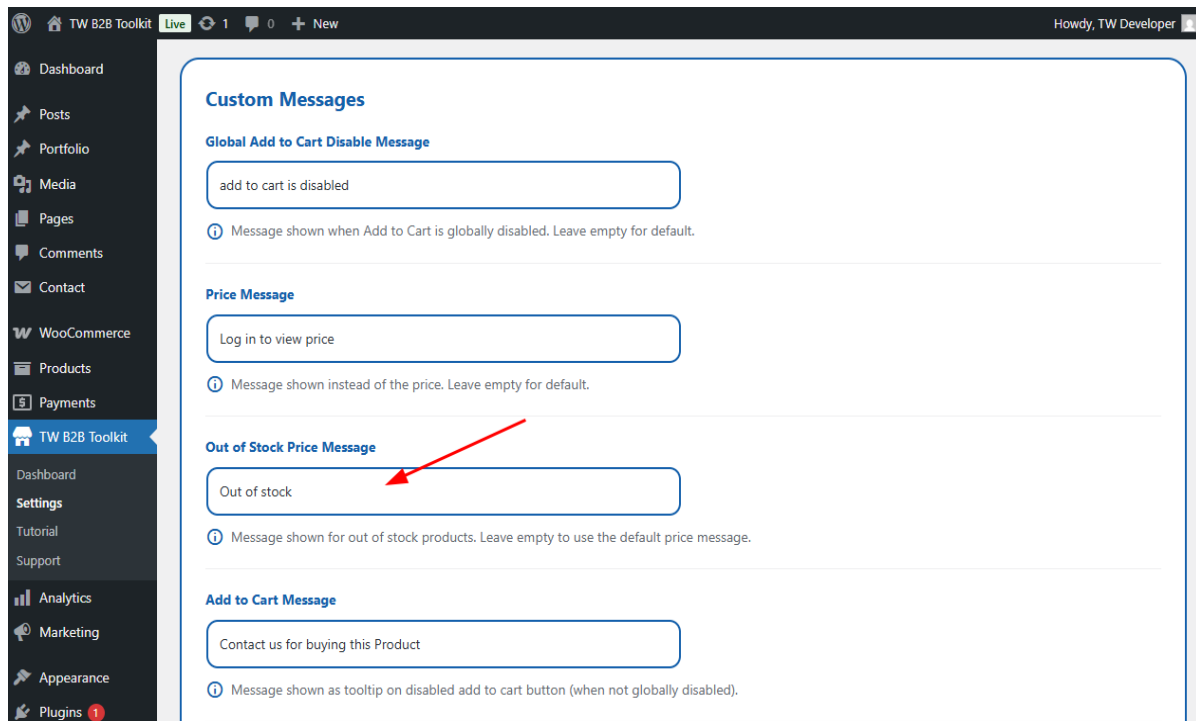

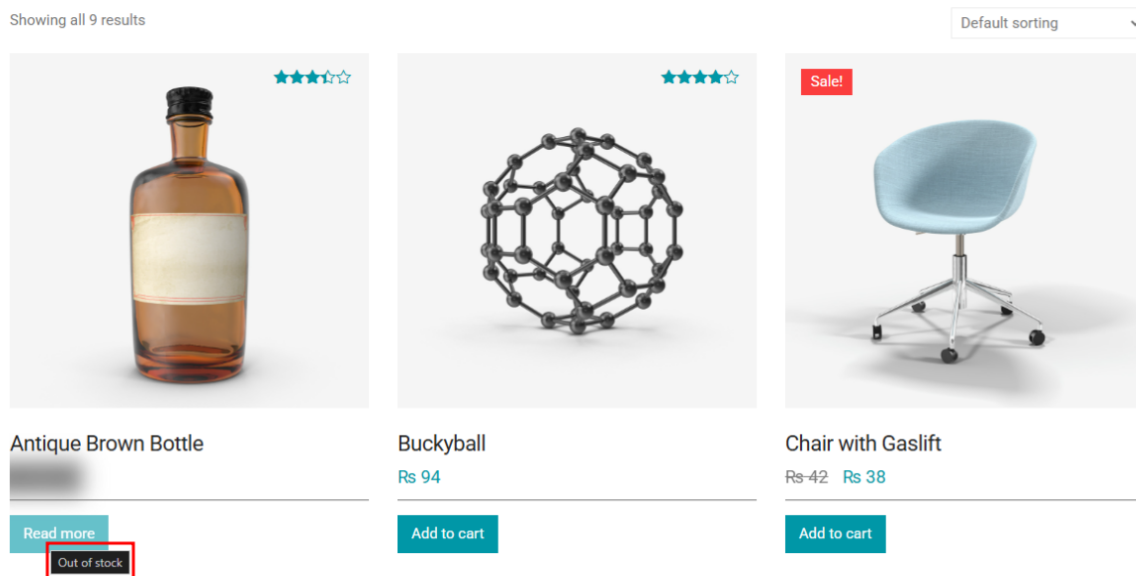

4.1.7.5. Schedule Active Message

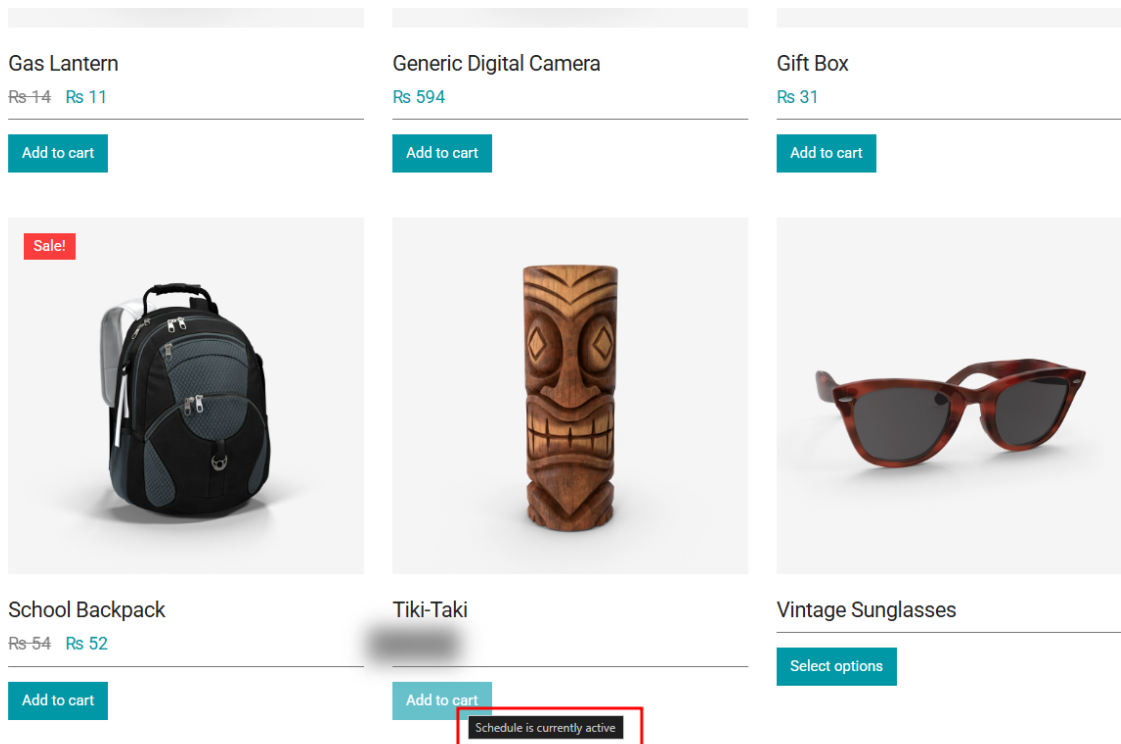

4.1.7.6. Role Restricted Message

The Role Restricted Message feature allows store owners to display a custom tooltip message for restricted WooCommerce user roles affected by User Role Restrictions.

This helps explain why specific logged-in users cannot view prices or purchase products.

How It Works

When the **User Role Restrictions** feature is enabled:

- The tooltip message feature is automatically activated.
- By default, the plugin displays the message "Your account does not have permission to view pricing."
- A custom tooltip message appears when users hover over:
 - Hidden product prices
 - Disabled Add to Cart buttons
- The message is displayed for logged-in users affected by user role restrictions.
- When User Role Restrictions are enabled, **only the Role Restricted Message will be displayed to the affected users**. Any tooltip messages configured in the plugin will be ignored for those user roles.

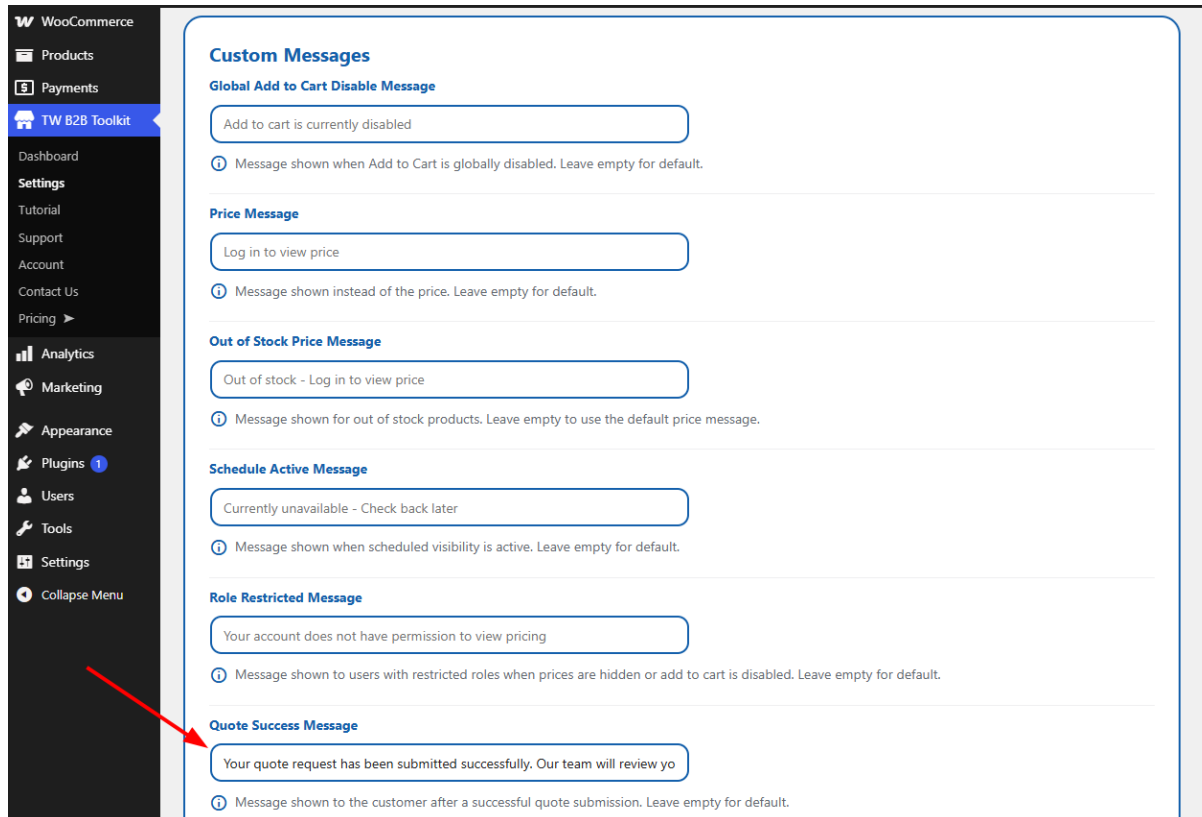

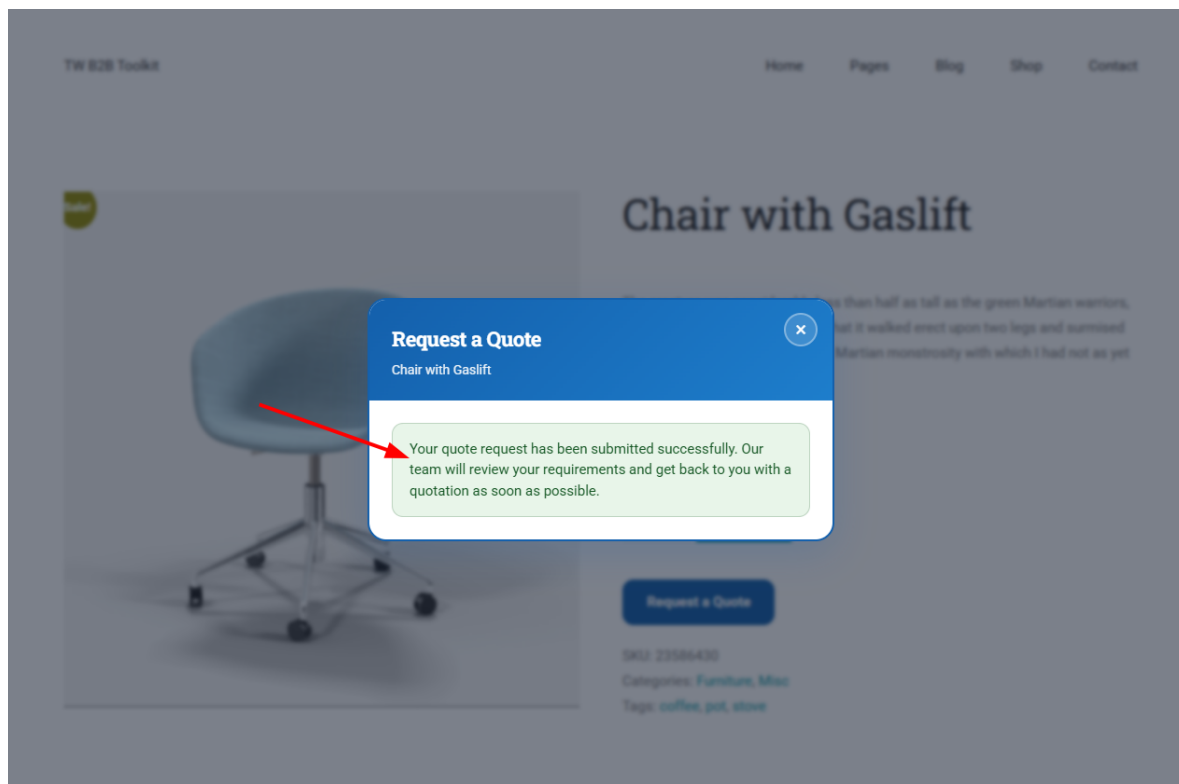

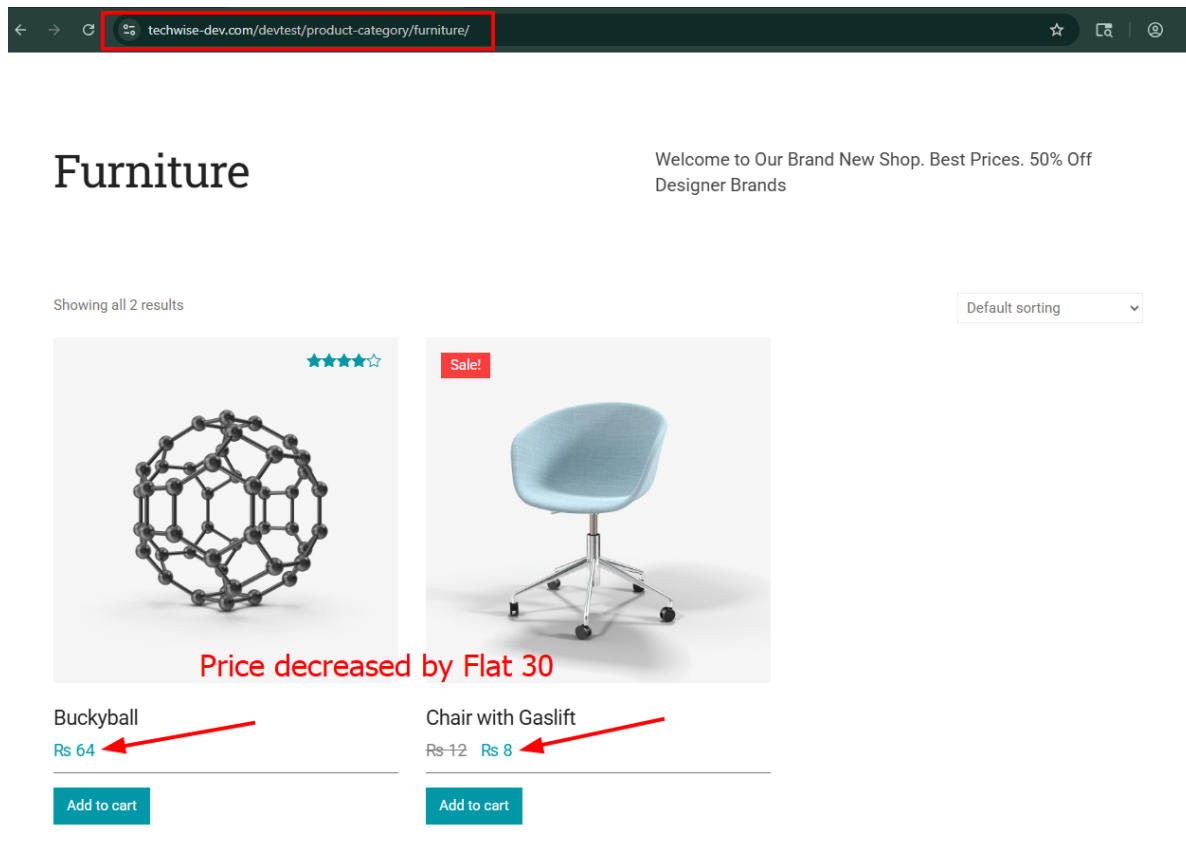

4.2.2. Product Selection Table

All Categories Selected:

If "**All Categories**" is selected, all store products will be displayed in the table. You can:

- Select multiple products
- Select all products
- Apply bulk price changes using percentage or flat pricing

Specific Category Selected:

If you select a specific category, such as **Category A**, only products from that category will appear in the table.

You can then:

- Select individual products
- Select multiple products
- Select all products from the category
- Update prices in bulk or individually using percentage or flat rules

4.2.3. Apply Bulk Pricing Changes

After configuring the **pricing** rules:

1. Select the products you want to update.
2. Review the pricing configuration carefully.
3. Apply the pricing update.

The plugin will automatically update the selected WooCommerce product prices using the configured pricing rules.

4.2.4. Recent Bulk Changes Table

The Recent Bulk Changes Table allows store owners to track and review recent WooCommerce bulk pricing updates performed through the Bulk Price Manager.

What the Table Displays:

Each bulk pricing log entry includes:

Last Updated Date & Time:

Displays the exact date and time when the bulk pricing operation was applied.

This **helps store** owners:

- Track recent pricing activity
- Verify update timing
- Monitor pricing operations

Bulk Update Type:

Displays the pricing rule type used during the update.

Supported update types:

- Percentage
- Flat

Examples:

- Percentage Increase
- Percentage Decrease
- Flat Increase
- Flat Decrease

Category:

Displays the WooCommerce product category affected by the pricing update.

If the update was applied store-wide:

- The table will display **All Categories**

Assigned Value:

Displays the numeric value used for the pricing update.

Examples:

- 10%
- 15

This helps identify the exact pricing rule applied during the operation.

Total Products Affected:

Displays the number of WooCommerce products updated during the bulk pricing operation.

This helps verify:

- Update scope
- Product coverage
- Bulk operation impact

How It Works

Whenever a bulk pricing update is successfully applied through the Bulk Price Manager:

- A new log entry is automatically created.
- The updated information is stored in the Recent Bulk Changes Table.
- Multiple pricing operations can be tracked over time.

The table updates automatically as new bulk pricing changes are performed.

Important Notes:

- Pricing changes apply directly to WooCommerce product prices.
- Decimal pricing values are supported.
- Product prices can be updated multiple times using different pricing rules.
- Previous pricing updates can be tracked using the Price History feature.

Does the plugin work with variable products?

Yes. The plugin supports both simple and variable WooCommerce products.

Are logged-in users affected?

Can I replace the Add to Cart button with Request a Quote?

Yes. The Button Display Mode allows you to either display the Request a Quote button alongside the Add to Cart button on single product pages or replace Add to Cart buttons throughout your WooCommerce store with the Request a Quote button.

Does the Request a Quote button appear on shop pages?

It depends on the selected Button Display Mode. When the Show Add to Cart Button Alongside Quote is selected, the Request a Quote button appears only on single product pages. When Replace Add to Cart with Request a Quote is selected, the Request a Quote button replaces Add to Cart buttons throughout the WooCommerce store, including shop, category, tag, and other product archive pages.

Can customers include additional information with their quote request?

Yes. Enable the Quote Message Field option to allow customers to include an optional message when submitting a quote request.

Can I customize the success message after a quote request?

Yes. You can configure a custom Quote Success Message. If left empty, the default success message is displayed.

Where are quote requests sent?

Quote requests are sent directly to the site admin email address.

Can I schedule visibility rules?

Yes. You can configure start and end dates/times to automatically activate and deactivate the **Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart** feature. Scheduling applies to all configured visibility rules, including:

- Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart (all products)
- Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart by Category

- Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart by Product
- Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart by Tag
- Hide Price & Disable Add to Cart by Brand

Does scheduling affect Global Add to Cart Disable?

No, Global Add to Cart Disable works independently from scheduled visibility.

Can I hide prices only for out-of-stock products?

Yes. Enable the out-of-stock visibility. Control feature to automatically hide prices and disable Add to Cart buttons for out-of-stock products.

Can I display custom messages instead of prices or "Add to Cart" buttons?
